

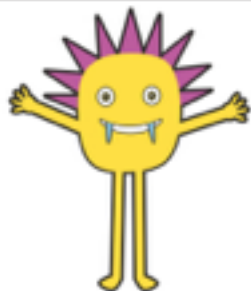
Dear Parent/ Carer,

We have put together a bank of resources to help support your child with phonics. Please find attached a list of the sounds which your child should be able to pronounce and identify by the end of Year 1. There is also a list of 'Tricky Words' and 'High Frequency Words'. Tricky Words cannot be sounded out, therefore your child will need to know how to spell these words. High Frequency Words can be sounded out and will need to be practised as these are words that your child will use.

There is also an example of Nonsense words also known as Alien words that your child will be expected to read, however these are not real words.
